Dear Parents/Caregivers and Students

Thank you for your support of our school community and each other during these challenging days.

I am writing to you, to ensure that you have accurate and up to date information regarding the Roma Mitchell situation.

We have had a few questions about whether the announcement of a state-wide lockdown has had an impact on the information that was provided by SA Health.

The SA Health information for us **has not changed**.

All staff and students who were present at our school on Thursday 12 and or Friday 13 November must quarantine until the end of Friday 27 November. All members of your household must also quarantine. The announcement does not change this for us.

This means that you cannot leave your house unless there is a medical emergency or to get a Covid Test. SA Health have now set up a mobile testing station in the carpark of our school.

SA Health information to us was clear, all members of your household must be tested as soon as you are able to and then get re tested on 24 or 25 November. Remember you must take your Medicare Card with you when you are being tested.

If you have any questions you can contact the SA COVID19 information line on 1800 253 787. As of today, SA Health have also set up a hotline especially for Roma Mitchell. If you have any questions or concerns, phone 7425 71 66.

I understand that this will be a challenging time for you all. Your child's care group teacher will be in touch with your child via Daymap early next week.
